Public Communication. The public is welcome to address the City Council on items on the Consent Calendar or other items not listed on the agenda but within the Council’s jurisdiction during the general Public Comment period. There is an opportunity for the public to comment on other agenda items at the time they are discussed. Comments are generally limited to three minutes.

Public Participation Options

- 2) **Submit Written Comments by 4 pm the Day of the Meeting** to CityCouncil@pleasanthillca.org (comments received by the deadline will be provided to the City Council before the meeting). Please specify that the correspondence is for public comment at the Council meeting.

3) Make Public Comment During the Meeting

When the Mayor invites public comment (or public comments on specific agenda items), you may participate in one of the following three ways:

a. Via Zoom

Go to www.Zoom.us using your computer/smart device and enter the Meeting ID and Passcode provided near the top of the agenda. You are encouraged to turn on your camera/video with a blurred background during your public comment so the City Council and public can see you on screen. We ask that you state your name and city of residence for the records when you start your comments.

Please use the "Raise hand" feature in Zoom. You will be observing the meeting as an Attendee and will not be seen or heard until it is your turn to speak. You will be invited into the meeting as a Panelist and asked to speak when it is your turn.

- Try to be in a room or space without a lot of background noise.
- Mute your microphone until it is your turn to speak.
- Have a strong, reliable internet connection.

b. Via Phone

Call **(669) 900-6833** and enter the Meeting ID and Passcode. Dial *9 to virtually “raise your hand” to alert staff that you wish to speak. *(Note that there may be multiple hearing items on the same agenda.)* We ask that you state your name and city of residence for the record when you start your comments.

- Have a strong, reliable internet connection or cell phone signal.

c. In Person

Members of the public may attend the meeting in person subject to the limited space available. You may speak on any matter within the City Council's jurisdiction. Please fill out a speaker's card, available at the entry to the Council Chambers, and turn it in to the City Clerk.
