POSITION: Pleasant Hill Chamber of Commerce Member

Participation on the Measure K Oversight Committee is a way for a busy person to give back to the community with a minimal time commitment. The committee meets two to four times per year, and reviews financial reports to confirm expenditures are used towards the new Pleasant Hill library or infrastructure improvements as approved by residents at the November 8, 2016 election.

PURPOSE: The Measure K Oversight Committee (Committee) reviews semi-annual revenue and expenditure reports, and other relevant reports and information regarding the half-cent tax approved by voters to verify expenditures are appropriate. The seven-member Committee provides an annual report to the City Council and makes recommendations if needed.

QUALIFICATIONS: Candidates must be at least 18 years of age, and be a member of the Pleasant Hill Chamber of Commerce with a business in Pleasant Hill.

TERMS: One Vacancy – Term Through May, 2024

MEETING SCHEDULE: The Committee meets approximately two to four times per year with specific meeting dates to be determined by the chair. Meetings are held within the City of Pleasant Hill or via teleconference.
