To qualify as a candidate, you must be a citizen of the United States and a resident of Pleasant Hill for at least one year prior to appointment. Meetings are held on the 2nd and 4th Tuesday of each month at 6:30 p.m. at City Hall.* ***There is one vacancy for an unfilled term through April 2024.***
