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## NOTICE OF VACANCIES

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that vacancies have or will occur on the following Commissions:

### COMMISSION ON AGING

The Commission on Aging considers all matters affecting the aging in the community; provides awareness of resources; plans, promotes and participates in events of benefit to the aging population. Qualifications include experience, training or education in provision of programs or services for senior citizens is preferred, with a sincere desire to be of service to the older population of Pleasant Hill. Candidates may be non-residents or under 55 years of age. Meetings are held on the 2<sup>nd</sup> Thursday of each month at 5:00 p.m. at City Hall.\* *Two vacancies are expected: four-year terms, May 2022 through April 2026.*

### EDUCATION COMMISSION

The mission of the Commission is to advocate for quality public education in Pleasant Hill. The commission advises the City Council and acts as a conduit between the City and the Mount Diablo Unified School District. Candidates must reside in either Valley View or Pleasant Hill Middle School attendance areas and need not be a City resident. Meetings are held on the 4<sup>th</sup> Thursday of each month at 7:00 p.m. at City Hall. *Four vacancies expected: four-year terms, May 2022 through April 2026.*

### MOSQUITO & VECTOR CONTROL DISTRICT BOARD OF TRUSTEES

The Contra Costa Mosquito & Vector Control District is a tax-funded special district responsible for the county-wide control of mosquitoes, rats, skunks and ground nesting yellow jackets. Candidates must be at least 18 years of age and a resident of Pleasant Hill with an interest in public health, public policy, wetlands, farming, community education, finance, personnel or land development. Trustees meet the second Monday of every other month at 7:00 p.m. at District offices in Concord, and may be appointed to committees that meet twice a month or as needed. *One vacancy is expected: a two-year term through March 2024 (for a new appointee) or one four-year term through March 2026 (for a reappointed person).*

### PLANNING COMMISSION

The Planning Commission provides recommendations to the City Council on land use, zoning, the general plan, and other policy issues. To qualify as a candidate, you must be a citizen of the United States and a resident of Pleasant Hill for at least one year prior to appointment. Meetings are held on the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Tuesday of each month at 6:30 p.m. at City Hall.\* *Two vacancies are expected: one unfilled term through April 2024; one four-year term, May 2022 through April 2026.*
