NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that vacancies have or will occur on the following Commissions:

CONCORD/PLEASANT HILL HEALTH CARE DISTRICT GRANT COMMITTEE

The Concord/Pleasant Hill Health Care District Grant Committee was established to review grant applications and to make recommendations to the District's Board of Directors (the Concord City Council) for granting of tax revenue dollars annually received by the District. The representative must be a resident of Pleasant Hill with an interest in understanding the opportunities provided by organizations seeking funding to serve the community. A background in interpreting business plans and financial statements is desirable. The committee meets in Concord as needed based on grant cycles. *One vacancy: four-year term July 2022 through June 2026.*

CONTRA COSTA COUNTY LIBRARY COMMISSION

The Library Commission serves in an advisory capacity to the County Board of Supervisors and the County Librarian. The Commission serves as a forum for the community to express its views regarding the goals and operations of the County Library, and develops and recommends proposals for the betterment of the County Library. Applicants must be Pleasant Hill residents. Meetings are held every other month on the 4th Thursday at 7:00 p.m.* *Two vacancies (including alternate commissioner): four-year terms, July 2022 through June 2026.*

EDUCATION COMMISSION

The mission of the Commission is to advocate for quality public education in Pleasant Hill. The commission advises the City Council and acts as a conduit between the City and the Mount Diablo Unified School District. Candidates must reside in either Valley View or Pleasant Hill Middle School attendance areas and need not be a City resident. Meetings are held on the 4th Thursday of each month at 7:00 p.m. at City Hall. *Two vacancies: four-year terms, May 2022 through April 2026.*

PLANNING COMMISSION

The Planning Commission provides recommendations to the City Council on land use, zoning, the general plan, and other policy issues. To qualify as a candidate, you must be a citizen of the United States and a resident of Pleasant Hill for at least one year prior to appointment. Meetings are held on the 2nd and 4th Tuesday of each month at 6:30 p.m. at City Hall.* *One vacancy: four-year term, May 2022 through April 2026.*
