

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARINGS BEFORE THE
PLEASANT HILL CITY COUNCIL
(Transition to District-Based Elections for City Council Members)**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on May 22, 2023, the Pleasant Hill City Council will conduct a public hearing to receive comment from the public regarding the draft maps for district-based elections for Members of the City Council, pursuant to the California Voting Rights Act (CVRA).


In accordance with California Elections Code section 10010(a)(1), the City Council conducted public hearings regarding the establishment of district boundaries for district-based elections on March 20, 2023, April 3, 2023, April 17, 2023, May 1, 2023 and May 6, 2023.

The City's demographer prepared electoral division maps consistent with federal and state law outlining the proposed boundaries of the electoral divisions, and the draft maps are available on the City website at www.pleasanthillca.org/districts. The public is invited to provide input regarding the content of the draft maps. Those desiring to be heard on the item will be given an opportunity to do so during the public hearing on May 22, 2023 (7:00 p.m.).

The City Council will then take steps at future public meetings in June, 2023 to adopt an Ordinance transitioning the City from an at-large to district-based method of electing members of the City Council, approving the establishment of electoral division map boundaries, and approving the sequence of future Council elections, if applicable.

This public hearing will be conducted in the City Council Chamber, located at 100 Gregory Lane, Pleasant Hill, California, 94523. The agenda will be posted in advance of the meeting in compliance with the requirements of the Ralph M. Brown Act and can be viewed at www.pleasanthillca.org/agendas.
